## **Norman Oklahoma's November Arts Market Will Include COGRS Model Railroad Layout**

**Norman's November Downtown Arts Market is Saturday, November 15th in front of the Santa Fe Depot, 200 S. Jones Ave.**

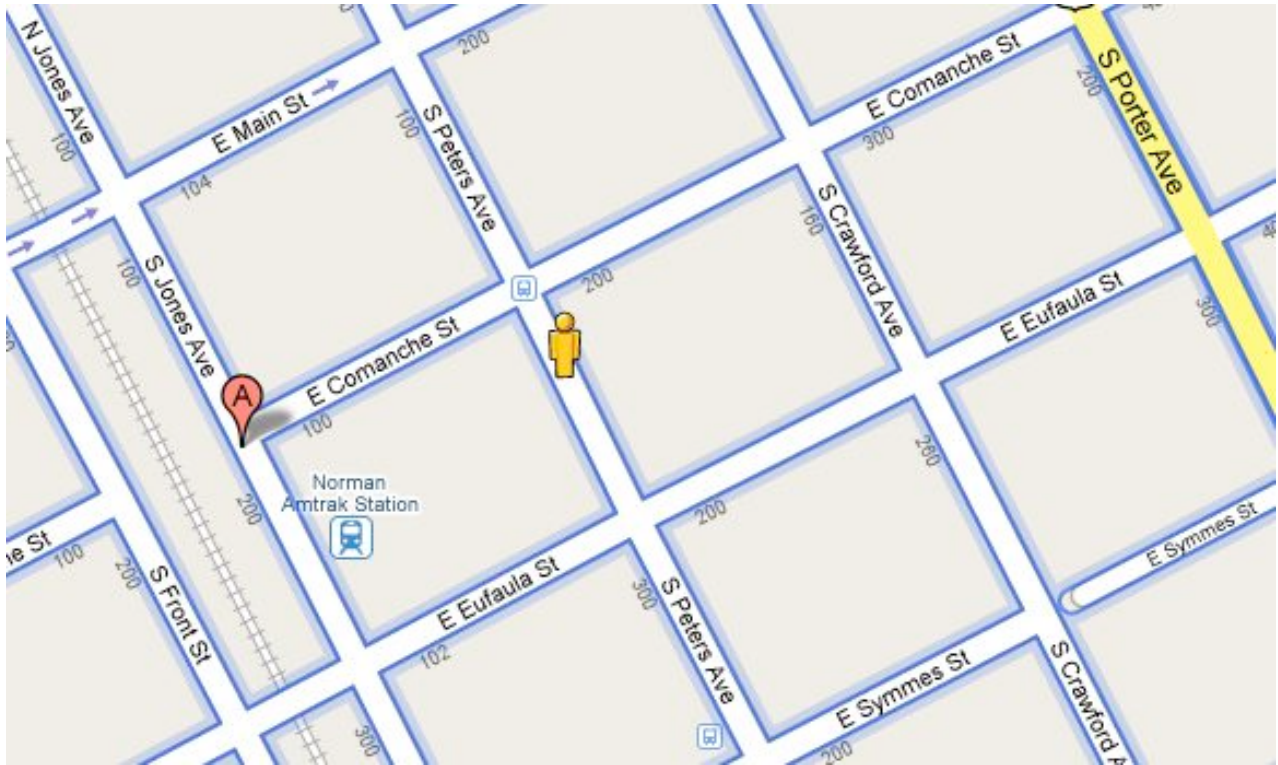
**The fall markets include local artists, a street chess championship, story telling and crafts for children, performance art, live music, local farmers, Oklahoma wineries and tents representing non-profit organizations in the Norman community. The Downtown Arts Markets will be held along Legacy Trail on Jones Avenue between Main and Eufala streets (in front of the Santa Fe Depot). Each market will be 10 a.m.-3 p.m. and is open to all ages.**

**This year the November Market will include an operating G Scale model railroad layout presented by the Central Oklahoma Garden Railroad Society. The layout will be running in the main lobby of the Norman Train Depot from 10-3 on Saturday and again from 1-5 on Sunday.**

### **Getting there:**

From I-35 take either the Lindsey or Robinson exit east to Porter. From the north take Porter to E. Comanche Street and turn right. From the south take Porter to East Eufala and turn left. The Amtrak station is midway between Comanche and Eufala at 200 S. Jones Avenue.
